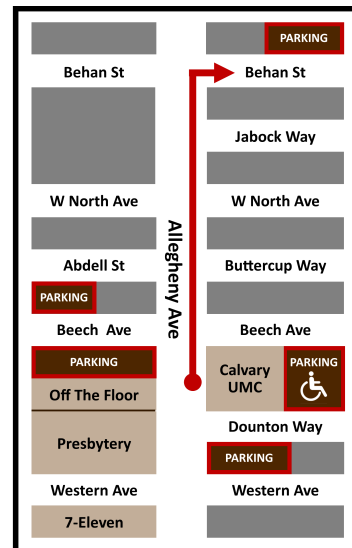


## MESSAGE FROM CALVARY'S HOSPITALITY PARKING TEAM
